Florida Attorney Samuel Bearman Gives Lecture on Hurricane Law to Academy of Florida Trial Lawyers

Pensacola, FL – June 22, 2006 – Attorney Samuel W. Bearman, based in Pensacola, Florida, spoke to the members of the Academy of Florida Trial Lawyers (AFTL) on June 8, 2006 at their annual convention in Hollywood, Florida.

Bearman's lecture, "*Responding to an Unwelcome Visitor: Hurricane Claims Under the 'Old Law' and the 'New Law'*" is one of the many lectures he has given to lawyers (and laymen) on the laws and procedures related to filing a hurricane claim.

He has spoken to various lawyer associations and CLE groups, and has written, "*Hurricane Insurance Claims*" which was published in the AFTL Journal.
